

## **2012 Nova Scotia Skills Competition**

**Official Competition Name: Mechanical CADD**

**Competition Level: Post Secondary**

### **Competition Rules**

**Competitors must attend the orientation, which will begin at 8:30 A.M. in the competition area.**

**Competitors requiring clarification of any instructions during the Competition should seek clarification only from the Judges.**

**A minimum score of 60% will be required to be eligible to receive a medal.**

**Competitors may not speak to other competitors or spectators at any time during this competition unless approved by the judges.**

**This includes family, friends, classmates, advisors, or employers.**

**If so, competitors may be disqualified at the judge's discretion.**

**Competitors may not communicate digitally with anyone at any time during the competition using a mobile device.**

**If so, competitors will be disqualified.**

**Competitors are not allowed to use the Internet at any time during this competition. Any competitor seen using the Internet will be disqualified.**

**During this competition, no one will have access to the immediate competition site except the judges and competitors.**

**Competitors may be excused for washroom or other breaks.**

**In accordance with the NSCC Smoke Free policy, "smoking is not permitted in NSCC buildings or on NSCC grounds." Therefore, competitors will not be permitted to smoke while attending this competition.**

**The lunch break will be taken as indicated in the Competition Schedule. Skills Nova Scotia will provide lunches and refreshments for competitors & judges.**

**Food & beverages will not be allowed at the competition workstations.**

**Competitors may bring texts, reference books, software reference manuals, tables, and calculators.**

**Reference materials may not be shared between competitors.**

**If so, competitors may be disqualified at the judge's discretion.**

**Any material brought by a competitor is subject to inspection and approval by the judges.**

**Competitors must be on-time for both parts of this competition. Late arrivals may be allowed but no "make-up" time will be given.**

**Competitors are asked to dress in a manner that is appropriate for a Provincial competition. Spectators at this competition may include: photographers, television crews, NSCC: staff– faculty–students, as well as members of industry and the general public.**

**Shirt and tie is not required, please do not wear: hats, baseball caps, or hoodies.**
